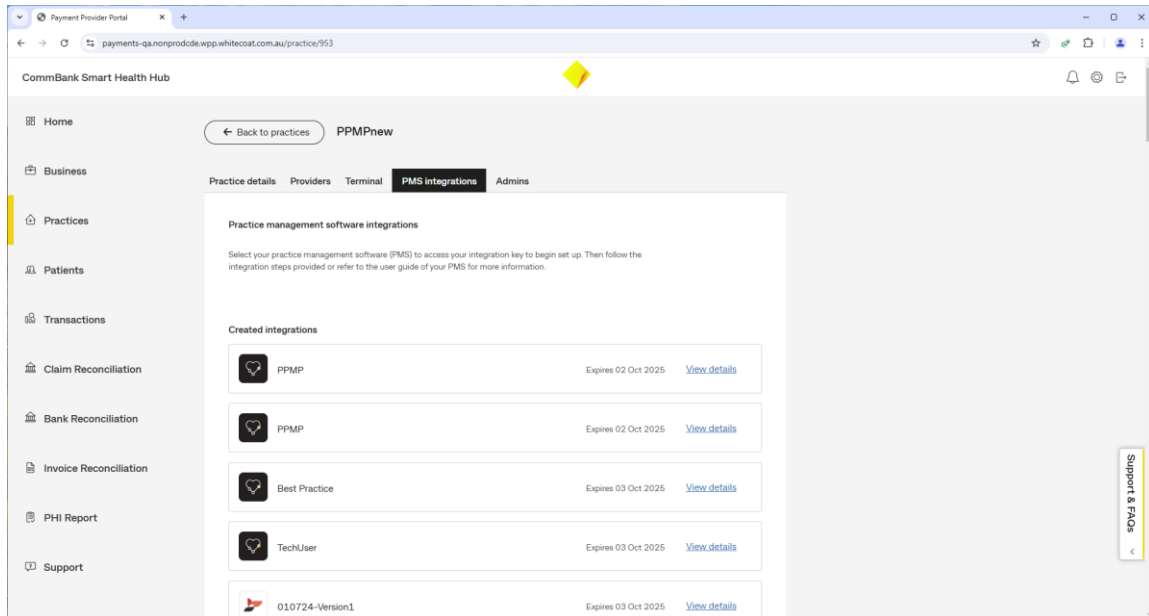
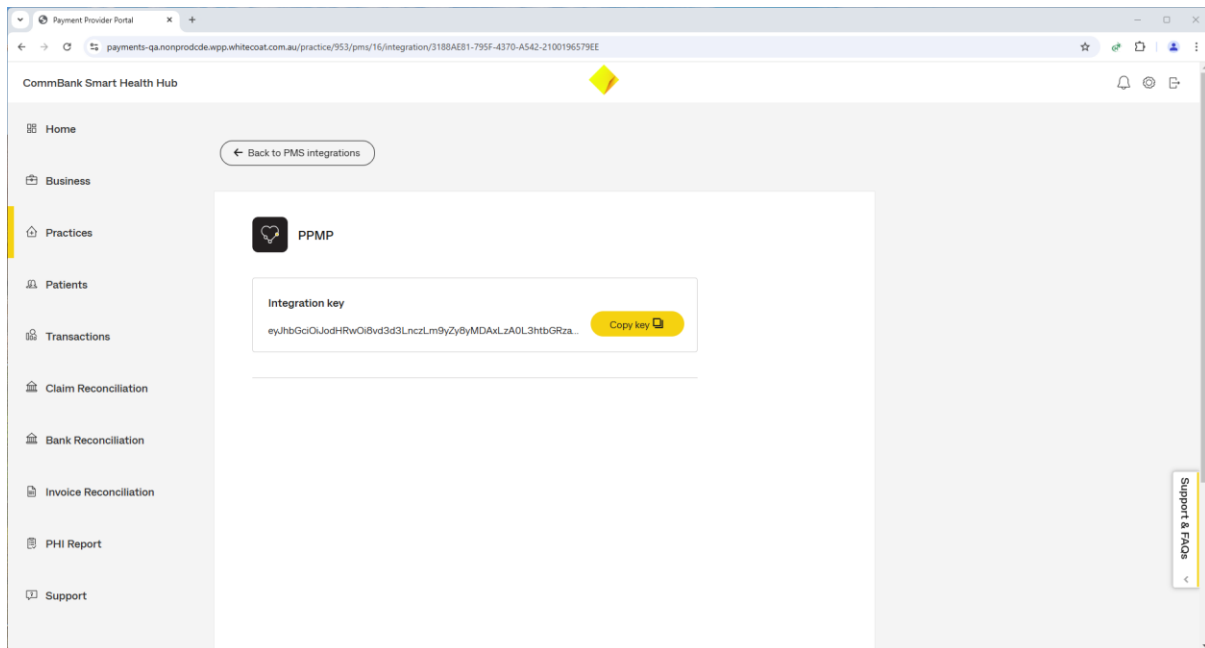


Step 1

- Select 'Copy Key' button

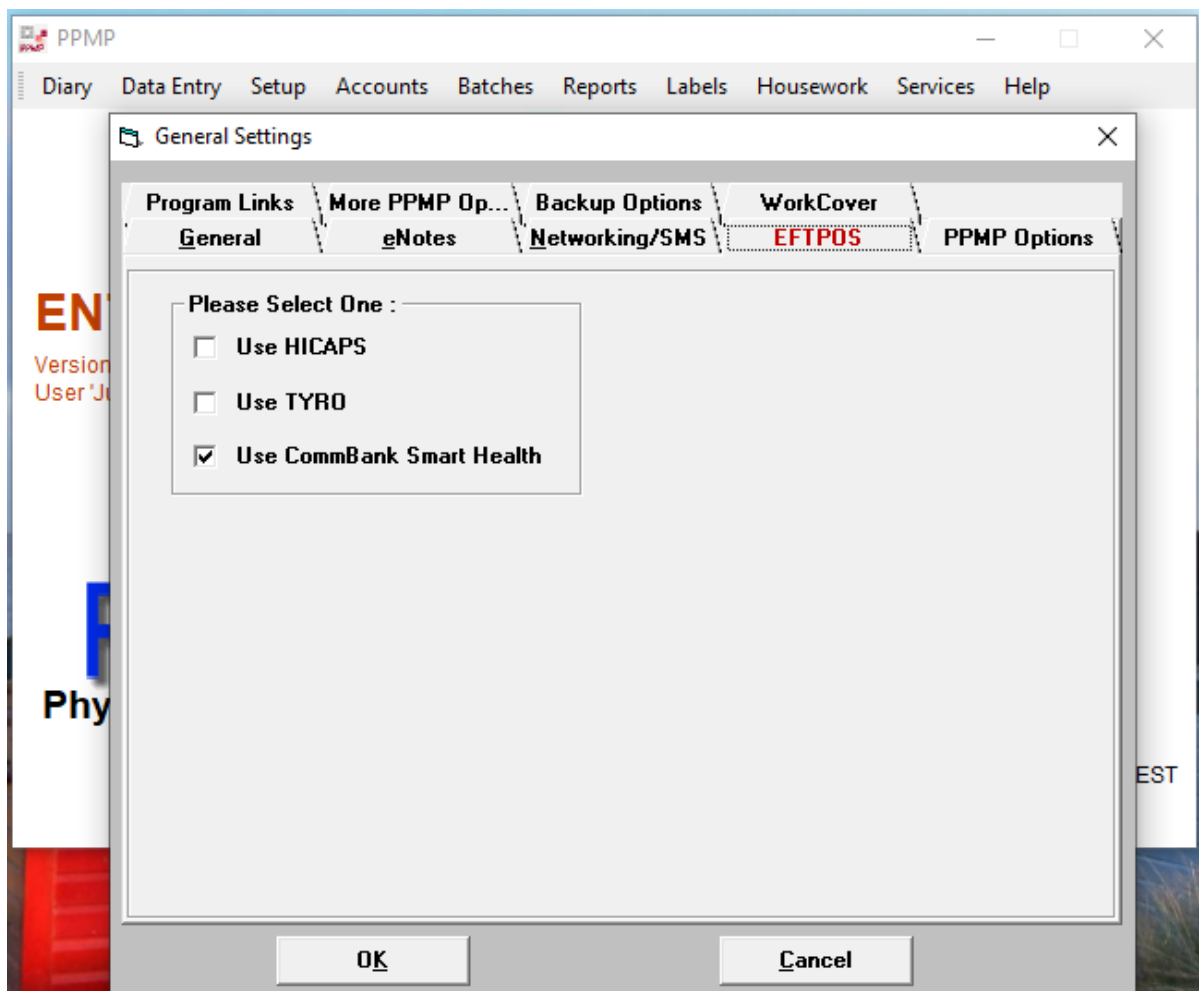

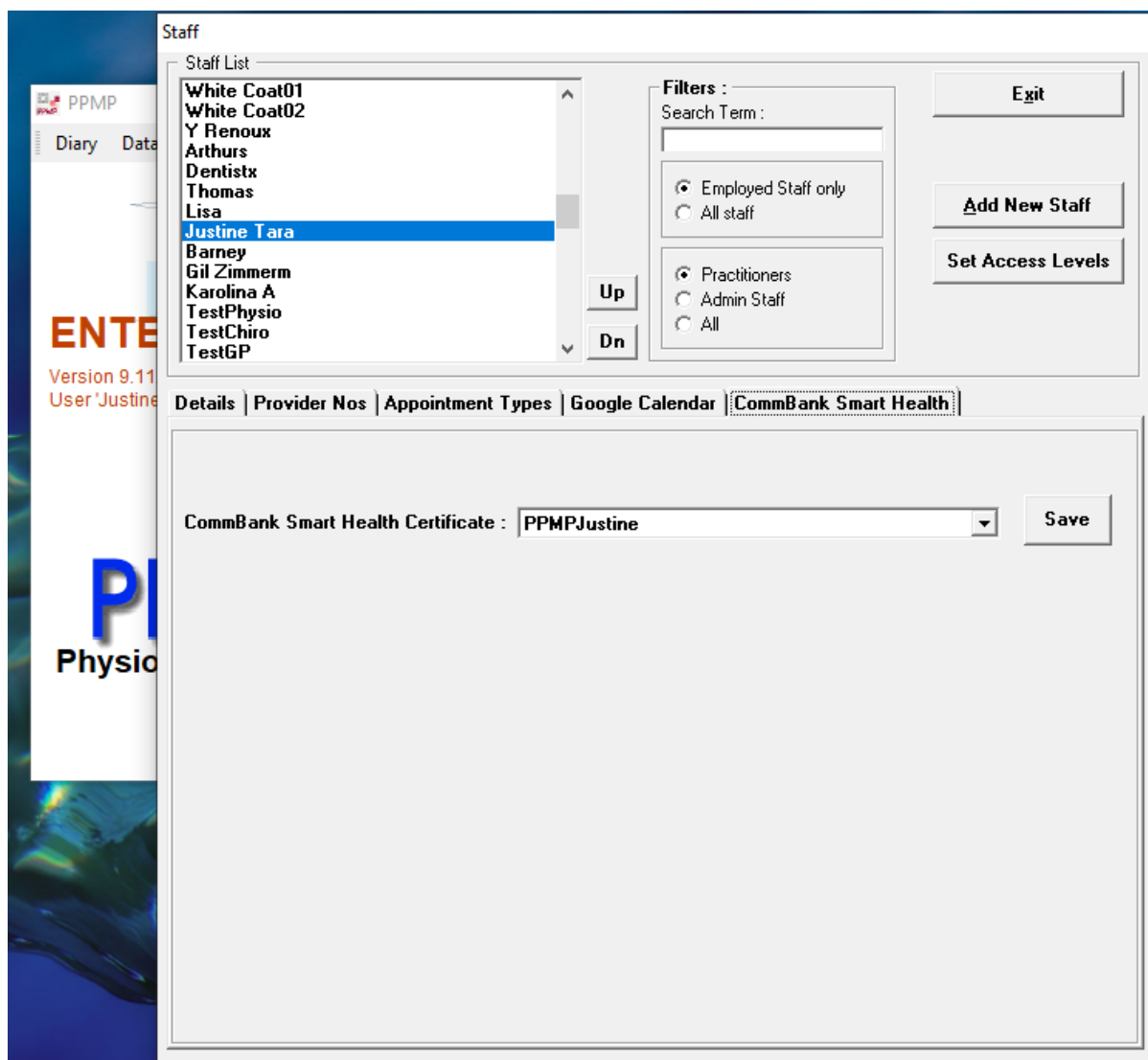
Configure PPMP with CommBank Smart Health settings

- a) Select CommBank Smart Health as the EFTPOS solution**
 - Log into PPMP
 - Select 'Setup' menu option
 - Select 'Computer Resource Usage' sub menu option
 - Select 'EFTPOS' tab
 - Select 'Use CommBank Smart Health' and then 'OK' button



c) **Assign Certificate Name to PPMP Staff members**

- Select 'Setup' menu option
- Select 'Staff' sub menu option
- Perform the following for each Staff member that will use CommBank Smart Health.
- Select staff member
- Select 'CommBank Smart Health' tab
- Select the appropriate CommBank Smart Health Certificate from the drop down list
- Select 'Save' button



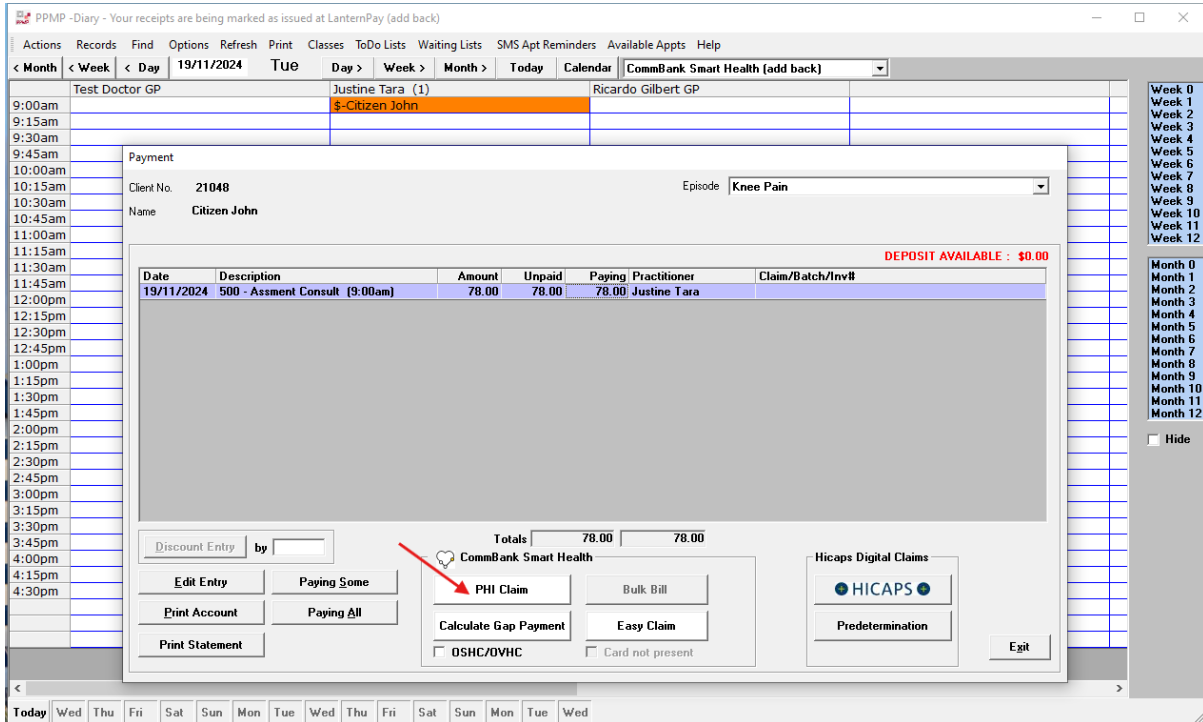
The setup is now completed and payments can now be made via the CommBank Smart Health system.

- B) Create a Treatment Charge against the patient

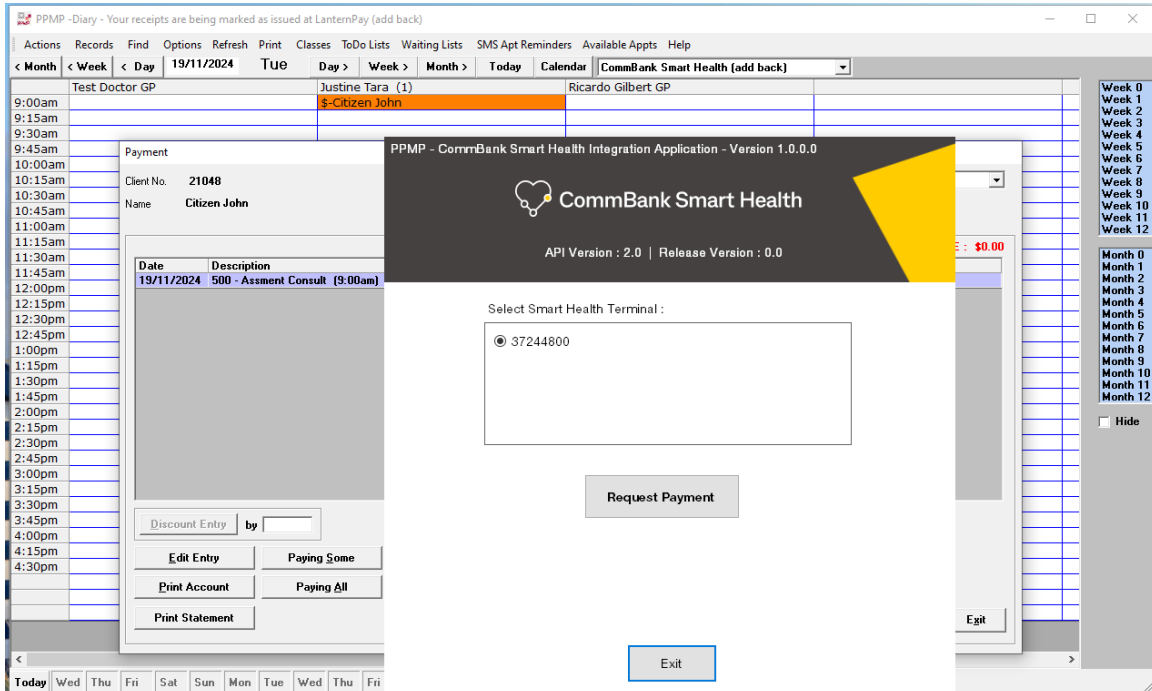

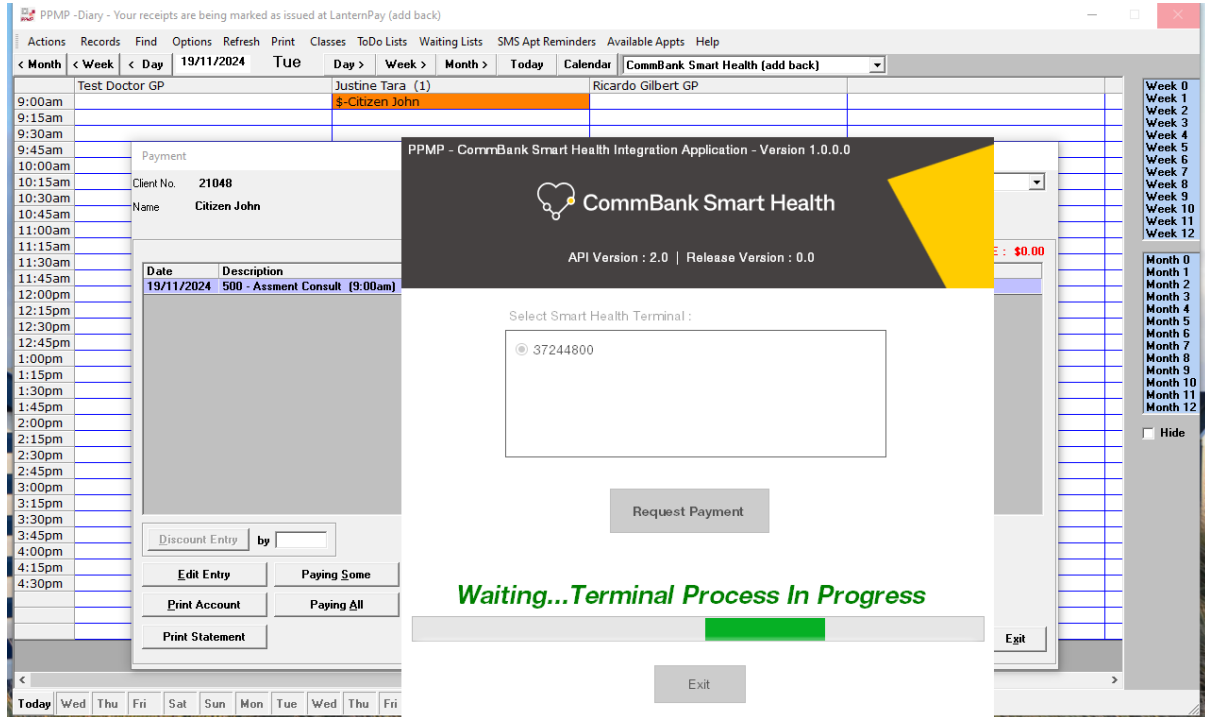
The CommBank Smart Health application window will appear.

The window will be updated with '...in progress'.

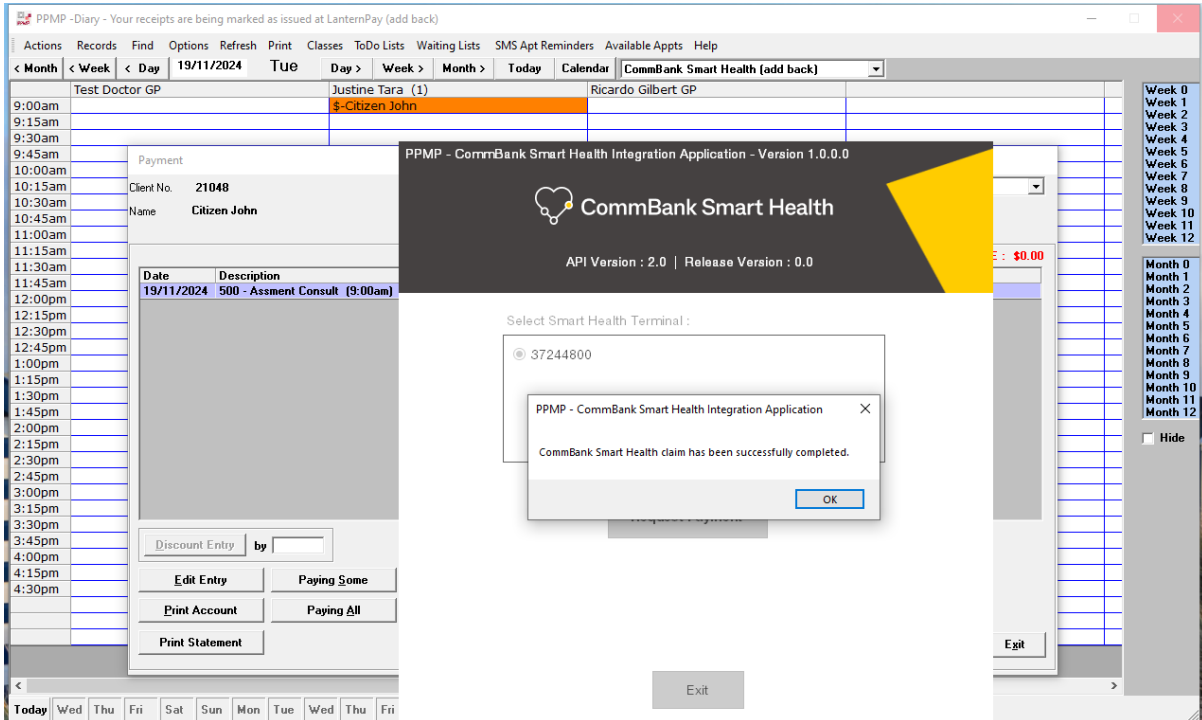
Control has now passed to the CommBank Smart Health terminal.
